

Skiatook Public Schools Student Technology Insurance Program 2022 - 2023 Grades 9 - 12

The Skiatook Public Schools Student Technology Insurance Program has been established to give parents the ability to purchase insurance for 1:1 Instructional Initiative devices for the 2020-2021 school year. The devices issued are HP ChromeBooks and include ChromeDesk Support at Skiatook High School. The insurance, if purchased, will cover the repair or replacement costs of the device. This is a voluntary program and families are encouraged, but not required to participate.

Typical NON INSURED Repair/Replacement Costs:*

ltem	Cost	Insurance Coverage
Chromebook (Complete)	\$329	If purchased, the SPS Student Technology Insurance covers 100% of the FIRST incident of damage or loss (including theft**) of the ChromeBook device, 50% of the SECOND incident of damage or loss (including theft**) of the ChromeBook device from the date of issue through the date of collection (Example: The student's device is covered from the start of their 9th grade year issuance through device collection at the end of the 9th grade year when insurance will be offered again at the beginning of the 10th grade year.) On the third Incident, the parent is responsible for all repairs and replacement costs. Exact* repair/replacement costs will be determined at the time of the repair. This coverage will reset each new school year, if insurance is purchased. The charging cord is NOT covered by the insurance program. If the charging cord is lost, the cost of replacement is \$35 and must be replaced by the time of collection.

Acts of intentional damage will not be covered by the

insurance. Keep in mind, according to the Responsible Use Agreement, parents are responsible for the full cost of any repair or replacement of all damage to or loss of the ChromeBook if insurance is not purchased at the time of device acceptance. Fee schedule will apply, thereafter (see insurance coverage below above).

**Insurance Claims of Theft must include a completed Skiatook Police Report or School Resource Officer Report, signed by a parent. Options for purchase: Skiatook High School office or schedule pickup/ChromeBook distribution. No Refunds. No Prorating.

If purchasing insurance, it must be purchased **BEFORE** the student takes possession of the ChromeBook device. Purchase into the insurance program is non-refundable. Students will turn in their device and charger during collection at the end of the school year.
